
# **BEING A SERVANT TO ALL**

It's clear in Mark's gospel that the disciples never fully understand what Jesus is teaching about discipleship. Today's gospel passage reveals they have no clue what Jesus is saying. He just finished telling them, for the third time, about the suffering that awaits him in Jerusalem. James and John approach him and asked for places of authority and power in his new kingdom. They wanted Jesus, "to do for us a favour." Their boldness is breathtaking!

Jesus must have felt disappointed when James and John put their request to him. These two disciples were called at the beginning of Jesus' ministry. They were in the inner circle of the disciples and, it's clear from today's gospel, they presumed they would have certain privileges and share in power when Jesus triumphed and established his

worldly kingdom. These fishermen may have left their boats behind, but they now have to drop their notions of glory, if they are to continue following Christ.

Being a disciple is not about power and prestige. It's not about the first places at table. It's about following Jesus' path to suffering and death. That's a difficult teaching, no



wonder the disciples were deaf to it. Today Jesus speaks of a particular form of sacrifice; being a servant to others. And more... "to be a slave to all." It's not about being served, Jesus says, it's about giving our lives for others, as he did. What's more, this suffering isn't just at the end of our lives, it's a constant dying to self for the sake of others. It's the way Jesus lived, and he asked his disciples do the same.


### ST DOMINIC'S PARISH SACRAMENTAL UPDATE


