Dear parishioners,

One of the challenges, but also one of the joys, of studying in Canada last year was singing the Divine Office – the psalms, particularly – for an hour or so each day in French. Even though I did not always understand every single word – sometimes I struggled to put together pronunciation, melody and meaning – I found that the melody always bound me to the other friars in a prayerful movement towards God.

There is a good reason why almost every religion known to humanity uses chant or song in its common prayer. A unison of voices binds the worshippers to each other and helps to create community; at the same time, it somehow helps to free the mind from the here and now, and allows

us to open ourselves a little more towards the transcendent.



I noticed the power of song to unite people in Papua New Guinea, too. The brothers who join us in PNG and the Solomons come from different places. Each place has its own

language – there are more than a thousand languages in Melanesia – and each has its own song. It takes work to overcome the differences and form one community. I found that singing, especially in the liturgy, really did bring us closer together. This was perhaps particularly so in some of the beautiful traditional chants of the Dominican liturgy, like the Salve Regina, Ave Regina Cælorum or O Lumen Ecclesiæ. There we were, Australians included, singing the praises of God and imploring the intercession of his Mother and St Dominic in a language which was not the mother tongue of anyone's homeland, but which joined us not only to each other and to God, but to all those generations which had gone before us in the Dominican family. It was the singsing bilong lain Dominikan. And it reminded us that our homeland is in heaven. (Phil 3:20)

Music is not really an optional extra in public prayer. Liturgy without music may still be fine and holy, but it is missing

something important. It's an egg without salt, a table missing a leg, a yacht without a spinnaker. I urge you, when there's singing at Mass, lose your self-consciousness and put some wind in the sails!
