"BE PERFECT JUST AS YOUR HEAVENLY FATHER IS PERFECT."



Teaching about holy, Jesus gives his followers a guide for holy living, "You must therefore be perfect just as your heavenly Father is perfect." That means we are called to be configured to the divine life, the eternal love that is the Father, Son and Holy spirit. Jesus also gives practical teaching about how to achieve this: love your enemies, pray for those who persecute you, break the vicious circle of violence by not

striking back violently. Our goodwill and our acts of love cannot be just for those we know and love but should embrace everyone, just as God creates and sustains all that there is.

It is so easy to respond to evil with evil. That is our natural instinct to do so. But, a harder yet more perfect way, is to let the negativity that we encounter die within us. Through the Holy Spirit, we can gain the strength to not retaliate the evil. It can stop with us. As Christians we are called to go against our natural inclinations and deflect the negative situations we find ourselves in. We can convert the evil and negativity we encounter in life into something good. We cooperate with God's grace when we allow the Holy Spirit to work through us to bring God's love into the world.

God took the greatest evil the world has ever known, when humankind crucified his son, and converted it into the greatest act

of love the world has ever known. But Christ cooperated with His Father's will. It was within Christ's heart that he made the decision to accept suffering and death for the forgiveness of humankind's sins. We too, in imitation of Christ can choose to endure suffering so that love can be brought into the world as well.

LOVE Your ENEMIES

To become perfect doesn't mean we should become doormats and let people

take advantage of us. Neither does it mean that we don't need judges and law enforcement officers to do their jobs. What simple step can we take to help break the cycle of hurt and retaliation? Maybe just a small act of generosity or a simple "I forgive you" is all you need - even if you don't feel all that merciful at the time. It may not be easy, but it has the potential to open up someone else's heart to God's grace and forgiveness.
