TO BE FIRST BY BEING LAST AND SERVANT OF ALL

Jesus' disciples discuss amongst themselves which one of them was to be the greatest. They obviously focus on themselves. How does Jesus respond to this? He presents a child to them and

says, "Anyone who welcomes one of these little children in my name, welcomes me; and anyone who welcomes me welcomes not me but the one who sent me."

What an odd thing to do! Why a child? Children are weak, vulnerable and needy. Children have always been the first to suffer from famine, disease.

war and dislocation. They are images of the marginalised, the powerless, the vulnerable and the insignificant. Jesus has identified with them.

Being first in the community tends to fall to the group of people with more money, more talent, more influential friends, more education, more charm. Being first was often a sign of power and had advantage on someone else in order to get better position. But Jesus goes against the flow of the society in order to be first in God's kingdom. In order to be first in God's kingdom, you must be willing to be last, to be a servant. You must be willing to put other's needs before your own. Being first isn't most important.

Sunday October 7th: Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary

The Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary this year falls on Sunday October 7. Most of us are familiar with the tradition that goes back many centuries, about the connection of St. Dominic with the beginnings of the Rosary devotion. To make this day and its week special, our parish will

- 1) host the Pilgrim Statue of Our Lady of Fatima from Saturday 6 October to Friday 12 October 2018 and say Rosary before midday weekday masses at 11:35am.
- 2) be part of a world-wide chain of praying the Rosary on Sunday.
- 3) adore the Blessed Sacrament from 4 till 5pm, ended with Benediction; Praying the Rosary at 4:15pm. (**NOTE**: Time changed, different from last weeks' notice).

Focussing now on Sunday October 7 2018 –Catholics in the United States, Poland, Australia, New Zealand, the United Kingdom, Ireland, Mexico, Central and South America, Canada and India will meet to pray the Rosary together for the strengthening of the family, rekindling of the Faith and continuing Godly protection for each country with each participating nation to pray for its own intentions on that day.

Participants will gather to say the Rosary for the well-being of our nation, our families and our pastors and religious.
