International Day of People with Disability (IDPwD) is a United Nations sanctioned day that is celebrated internationally on 3 December. It aims to promote awareness of the challenges faced by over 1 billion people living with disabilities in every aspect of political, social, economic and cultural life.



International Day of  
People with Disability

People with disability do not enjoy access to society on an equal basis with others, which includes areas of transportation, employment, and education as well as social and political participation. The right to participate in public life is essential to create stable democracies, active citizenship and reduce inequalities in society.

"On this International Day, let us reaffirm our commitment to work together for a better world that is inclusive, equitable and sustainable for everyone, where the rights of people with disabilities are fully realized." — António Guterres, UN Secretary-General.

The 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development pledges to 'leave no one behind', and to 'endeavour to reach the furthest behind first', where dignity of an individual person and equality among all is applied as the fundamental principle.

Bishop Don Sproxtton, Auxiliary Bishop of Perth and Bishop Delegate for the Australian Catholic Disability Council said last year that people's faith calls and challenges them to take action to ensure communities are open and active in promoting opportunities that include people with disability.

"This includes work opportunities, empowering people with disabilities to take an active role in leadership and ensuring our faith communities are accessible physically and attitudinally, guaranteeing 'no one is left behind', in particular, we need to ensure that people with disability living in remote and rural areas, those who are new to our country and those struggling with the ever-increasing daily expense of living are supported and encouraged in the most practical and appropriate manner", he said.

This year's IDPwD theme is "The Future is Accessible" #futureisaccessible. Businesses and their leaders have the opportunity to share their commitment and encourage their staff and customers to celebrate diversity and inclusion within workplaces and communities.

Events are held across Australia to celebrate and raise awareness of IDPwD, with the aim to showcase the skills, abilities, contributions and achievements of people with disability and promote a positive image of people with disability. 


