"WELCOMING THE STRANGER" 2019 PARISH APPEAL

"I was a stranger and you made me welcome." (Mt:25: 35) St Dominic's parishioners, responding to the call of

the Gospel, should feel proud of the help and support they have given to vulnerable asylum seekers and refugees over the past 5 ½ years.

At present the parish is helping 3 families. One is from Pakistan, with three children at Catholic schools in Dandenong. The father has a Safe

Haven 5 year visa and has serious health issues. The family moved into new accommodation last week and we have committed to paying their rent for 12 months. Another Pakistani family, without work rights and serious health issues, is also being supported by you for 6 months. And we have committed to helping a recently arrived Sri Lankan family in Air-St

port West referred by Fr Peter Carrucan who spoke at Dominic's last year.

Today we are having our 2019 parish appeal to help fund this continuing work which cannot continue without your generous
