We who have come from other lands to call Australia 'Home' have the responsibility of rectifying wrong doing not only to our Indigenous sisters and brothers, but to all newcomers. It is a time for us to embrace each other, and continue to develop the great Aussie spirit of a 'fair go' for all. At the same time, for newcomers, it is a time to review lifestyle, and leave behind the tensions experienced in their motherlands, to share their stories and to listen to ours. Australia Day should be inclusive for all people from all backgrounds, cultures and countries.

On Australia Day 35 years ago, I became an Australian citizen. It was a great opportunity to call Australia home. Australia Day will always be a special day for me.

AUDIO LOOP If you are wearing a hearing aid, the best place to hear in the church is in the middle near the audio loop

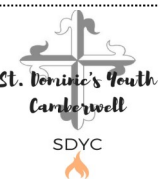

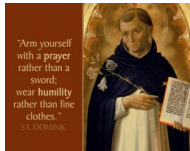
