"IN THE NAME OF THE FATHER AND OF THE SON AND OF THE HOLY SPIRIT"

Today we celebrate the feast of the Holy Trinity of one God. The threeness of one God is a profound mystery that expresses God, who chose to dwell among us, fully human and fully divine, and

then did not leave us orphans, but gave us a continual share in God's life through the gift of the Holy Spirit. It is this Spirit that continues to connect us to God and one another in love.

Jesus' final command to his followers is to "make disciples of all the nations; baptise them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit".



We are not only washed away our sins but also in the name of God, we are immersed into the life of God. Through baptism, we are participated in the body of Christ, we are then to share God's

Our belief in this mystery should open our eyes and make us conscious of God's presence. Today feast is not about words and formulas, but about celebrating the living presence of our God who dwells in our midst. God is not detached from our lives, but is intimately involved with us. God continues to act, speak and reveal God's self in the world today through us.

THE VISITATION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

To mark the end of May, the month of Mary, the Church celebrates the feast of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary to her cousin Elizabeth shortly after Annunciation.

Acknowledging Mary's visitation, Elizabeth proclaims Mary as the mother of my Lord and the most blessed among women.



Responding to Elizabeth's proclamation, Mary expresses gratitude for the abundant goodness and kindness of God: "My soul glorifies the Lord, and my spirit rejoices in God my Saviour."

The conversation of these two mothers-to-be utters their appreciation of God's grace in their lives.

It's good to see co-operation of the mothers' generation (Mary spends three months to help

Elizabeth) leads to that of their sons' generation (John the Baptist prepares the way for Jesus).

This is a time for us to pay close attention to how Christ is being formed in us, and to thank God for his blessing, since God's merciful love reaches the hearts of those who fear him.
