“KNOCK, AND THE DOOR WILL BE OPENED TO YOU.”



In today's parable a neighbour knocks in the middle of the night. In a small village everyone would know one another and they would have shared a common oven for baking. So, they would know where the best bread could be found to serve an unexpected guest. The petitioner on the outside requests the bread from a "friend."

The parable makes it quite clear that this is not a large fancy house, but a hut with family members inside stretched out asleep for the night. What a disturbance it would cause for a member of the household to get up and share from the family's breadbasket. It would also mean less for the family. Hospitality was inconvenient and risk taking.

Jesus' hearers are trained in the hospitality of the Middle East. Not to be gracious and welcoming to a traveller would be a stigma, not only on the host family, but on the entire village. The village would be disgraced and become known for its lack of hospitality. There was no suspense in this parable. The listeners would know what the answer was: you got up, no matter what the time of day or night, and generously filled the request. It would be unthinkable to hold back: sharing food was really sharing life and the rules of hospitality required sharing the best you had, the freshest bread.

When our lives get difficult, whether it's running out of bread when hospitality is called for, or running low on the resources of spirit, mind and psyche at critical moments, we are tempted to think that the Holy One is asleep behind a closed door. We feel very much on the outside. At these times it's important to hear the keyword in the parable – the one at whose door we knock is a "Friend."

NEWLY CANONISED DOMINICAN SAINT

Earlier this month the Holy Father declared that Blessed Bartholomew Fernandes (also called "Bartholomew of the Martyrs" after the church in Portugal in which he was baptised) should be accorded all the honours of sainthood.



Saint Bartholomew joined the Dominicans in his native Portugal, and, after a distinguished teaching career, reluctantly accepted appointment as Archbishop of Braga. At the Council of Trent he was a leading voice for reform of the Church at all levels. His reforms in Braga (like those of St Charles Borromeo in Milan) were used as a model for reform throughout the Church. His feast day is 18 July.

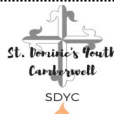
