"WELCOMING THE STRANGER" 2018 APPEAL

"I was hungry and you gave me food, I was a stranger and you made me welcome." (Mt:25: 35)

St Dominic's "Welcoming the Stranger" asylum seeker and refugee project has now been in existence for over 4 years. Responding to the call of the Gospel our aim has been to work on behalf of the parish to provide support to vulnerable asylum seekers who are in need of assistance while authorities work through their claim for asylum in Australia.



For the past 2 years the parish has provided accommodation in Hartwell for two adult Afghani sisters, Fahima and Nazifa, while also tutoring with their English, helping them dealing with Centrelink and general assistance with living in Australia society. The sisters lost most of their family and applied for asylum in Australia. Last year they were given a 5 year Safe Haven Enterprise visa. They are now ready to move on and we will endeavor to offer support in their ongoing interactions with Centrelink.

Previously in 2014 and 2015 the parish was able to help a Syrian family of four. They gained their permanent residency early in 2016 and now live independently in the northern suburbs. In 2016 St Dominic's entered into a partnership with St Bridget's parish in Greythorn to assist a Tamil family – parents and three young children - seeking asylum. Together the 2 parishes have been able to provide accommodation; with social support provided by the parishioners of St Bridget's.

Last year we were able to give financial help to an Afghani Hazara family of six in Preston East through the local St Vincent de Paul conference who are working with the family. While last month we received a request from Fr Peter Caruccan for help for a Sri Lankan family in Airport West. Father Caruccan will be concelebrating the 9:30am Mass today and speak at morning tea after that Mass.

Last year we organized for the banner 'St Dominic's Parish supports asylum seekers' that faces Riversdale Road and in February we organized the food collection for the Brigidine Asylum Seeker Project which you supported so well.

Today we are having our 2018 parish appeal to help fund this continuing work.

There are envelopes in the seats for your donation; these can be given to the collectors at the doors after Mass or returned to the parish office or at Mass next weekend. Any contribution you can make will be greatly appreciated and every dollar raised is spent on support for asylum seekers. Donations are tax deductible.

I would like to thank you most sincerely for your prayers and support in the wake of my bicycle accident on 14th March. I went straight over the



handlebars after my front wheel hit a hole in the road that I did not see. A very kind lady in a passing car stopped and assisted me, collected my damaged bicycle, called an ambulance and called the Priory. I was taken to the Alfred Hospital and spent several days in the Intensive Care Unit and then over a week Trauma Unit. The the care there excellent. I am now well on the mend, although doctors have advised that damaged nerves in the left arm on which I fell may take three months to heal, as also some fractured ribs. On the whole I think I was very lucky to escape with the few injuries that I have. The Lord has been kind to me. I am very deeply, but also \$\frac{1}{3}\$ may I say, very gladly in your debt.
