'boldly become citizens of the digital world'. It points out that we are called not just to be inhabitants of this world, but active citizens shaping it.

## **GENUINE HUMAN ENCOUNTER** IN OUR ONLINE WORLD

Pope Francis is calling each one of us to 'boldly become citizens of the digital world', with the image of the Good Samaritan as our inspiration. His call is not one that is oblivious to the many risks and threats encountered online. He says that this is a public square where people can truly engage and build each other up or attack one another and undermine the dignity of our neighbour.

At the interpersonal level there are experiences of cyberbullying, the objectification of women - particularly through the proliferation pornography, addiction to social media hyper-individualism.

At the community level there is the exclusion of a variety of vulnerable groups from the social and economic benefits of digital technology and a need to foster physical spaces where participation in online communities or movements can be made real.

There are also more global forces of injustice that threaten to undermine vital social, economic and political institutions. Platforms breaching users' privacy for the advertising dollar and malicious actors spreading misinformation to improperly influence elections are examples that spring to mind.

In the face of all of these challenges, Pope Francis has asked us to be a force for 'genuine human encounter' in the digital world. The bishops reflect at length on the theme that Pope Francis has mentioned in many of his World Communications Day messages:

'Genuine relationships are based on truth and develop over time. They are not fleeting or characterised by falsehood or discord. Relationships that are truly human recognise the dignity of the other, made in the image and likeness of God. They foster an integral development beyond immediate wants and needs to build the person socially, culturally and spiritually. True encounter makes real the love of God in the life of our neighbour. There can be nothing that isolates or divides.'

## **OCTOBER POPE FRANCIS'** EXTRAORDINARY MONTH OF MISSION

In 2019, to celebrate the 100th anniversary of Pope Benedict XV's Apostolic Letter Maximum Illud, Pope Francis announced that October will be an Extraordinary Missionary Month.

For the Extraordinary Missionary Month, the Holy Father has chosen the theme 'Baptized and Sent: The Church of Christ on a Mission in the World'. Awakening the awareness of the *missio ad gentes*. and reinvigorating the responsibility of proclaiming the Gospel with new enthusiasm, are themes that combine the pastoral concern of Pope Benedict XV in Maximum Illud with the missionary vitality expressed by Pope Francis in the Apostolic Exhortation Evangelii Gaudium: "Missionary action paradigm of every work of the Church" (EG 15).

## How to Live Your Own Extraordinary Missionary Month

There are four dimensions, specified by the Pope, to live more intensely the journey of preparation for the Extraordinary Missionary Month October 2019:

A personal encounter with Jesus Christ living in His Church through the Eucharist, the Word of God, personal and communal prayer;

missionary saints, martyrs confessors of the faith, as an expression of the Church scattered throughout the world;

Missionary formation: biblical, catechetical, spiritual and theological;

Missionary charity.
