RESPONSE TO THE CORONAVIRUS OUTBREAK

There are indications of the spread of coronavirus around the world. This offers us time to consider how we might respond to the virus before any urgency arises, and to play our part in preventing spread in the community. In order to be well prepared, we

- Cease distribution of Holy Communion by Chalice for the time being.
- Cease distribution of Holy Communion on the tongue for the time being in order to avoid transfer of saliva.
- Ensure that all Ministers of Holy Communion clean their hands with an alcohol based gel before and after distributing Holy Communion, and avoid all skin to skin contact.
- Temporarily empty Holy Water stoops of water.
- Make alcohol based gels or rubs available at entrances (Sorry that shops run out of this stuff. We'll try our best to get it A.S.A.P).
- Respect those who want to avoid physical contact at the Sign of Peace for the time being. Perhaps a bow or a smile seems adequate.

Thank you for your support in implementing these temporary measures which may offer comfort to those who are experiencing any anxiety at this time.

The WWCC can be completed online and as volunteers there is no cost involved. Many volunteers probably have this check already but for those who do not it is now paramount that this course of action be followed through in order to volunteer in our parish.

In order to keep our parish records accurate and up to date and to comply with the legislation, please make sure that our office has a copy of your current WWCC. This can either be emailed to secretary@stdominics.org.au or dropped into the parish office.
