Mid-term Stewardship Campaign Renewal

Dear parishioners, visitors and friends.

In August 2015 we celebrated our last Thanksgiving / Stewardship Campaign. As we are past the mid-way mark of the three-year term, it is time for us to take a look at our achievements.

One may say that parish life has two main pillars: the pastoral activities and the material aspects, of which both are equally important. From time to time during the year we remind ourselves of the various pastoral needs: Vinnies, the Austin, Heidelcare, Serve the Servers nights, and other ministries.

As parish priest it is also my duty to ensure that our buildings are maintained and enhanced. This requires continuous financial support. This year we have looked at the needs of the parish house meeting rooms and also general maintenance of the house. In the coming five years we will need to pay serious attention to some essential maintenance in our church.

Where does your money go? The money that is put in the parish side of the envelope goes to pay wages and current maintenance works. The money that goes in the priests' side is money for my living expenses. Part of that money is also forwarded to the bishop (5%) and to other priests (25%). The loose money is divided two thirds to the parish and one third to the priests.

We ask you to pledge / promise / budget the amount of money you can give to the parish on a weekly or monthly basis. This helps us to draw up our own plans and budgets. It is not enough for the parish to have enough money to cover current expenses, this way there will be no money for bigger projects that need to be undertaken. Also, wages and cost of living is always rising.

I kindly ask you to be generous and pledge to our thanksgiving / stewardship programme.
