Dear Parishioners, Friends and Visitors

Mary our mother!

We start the month of May, traditionally dedicated to Mary, mother of God and our mother!

Who is Mary? Mary is a person who totally listened to the word of God and let it take root in her life. She is one who built her house on solid rock and remained totally connected to the vine. This is the most basic and most relevant aspect of Mary's life. It is because of her total connectedness to doing God's will that she was free enough to say yes to God's invitation to be mother of his son. In Mary the word of God took life because of her commitment to God's will, before Jesus was conceived in her.

As a mother, Mary suffered when she saw her son going through his passion and death. She knows what it means to suffer. On the cross Jesus asked John the apostle to take Mary home as his mother. Under the cross John represented us, all who believe in Jesus.

Mary is one of us, totally human. She is the first member of the Church as she is the first to have believed in Jesus as Son of God. Like her we too are invited to build our life solidly on God's word and by doing this we too can give back Jesus, the Word of God, to the world we live in.

During this month I invite you to celebrate Mary, she is the mother of Jesus and our love of Jesus extends to his mother. In our parish we have two statues of Mary that can be taken home for one week. Anyone who would like to have the statue of Mary at home please put down your name on the sheet provided. This can also be a great time to gather the family around for moments of prayer.
