## Reflection on my 25 years of priestly ministry

Dear parishioners, visitors and friends.

This Monday, 3rd July, I give thanks to God for 25 years of priestly ministry. I also thank you parishioners who have insisted with me that we need to celebrate this occasion as a parish family. Thank you all for your support and generosity.

This occasion gives me yet another opportunity to reflect on what it means to be priest. A common image in our Christian tradition is to compare the relationship between priest and people to that of sheep and shepherd. Taking his inspiration from this image, Pope Francis encouraged priests to 'smell like the sheep;' inviting priests not to be afraid to working with and among the 'sheep.'

The One True Good Shepherd is indeed Jesus Christ, who gives up his life for us all; as priest my role is more like that of deputy to the shepherd. Moreover, the duty of the Christian is to listen to the voice of the True Shepherd and follow him as a faithful disciple.

As priest I am, first of all, a disciple. My duty to listen to the voice of the Shepherd and to continue my own faith journey in his footsteps. As I do this I have also been given the role of deputy shepherd with the duty to speak the words of the True Shepherd in a way that can be understood by the rest of the flock today. This is a very humbling experience.

It is a great privilege to have been asked, four years ago, to continue my journey with and within the parish community of St John's. Thank you for your generous welcome, sincere friendship and continued support. This trusting relationship makes it easier for us to be able to journey together.

Please continue praying for me daily so that I may continue to live faithfully my discipleship with you and among you.
