Dear parishioners, visitors and friends,

We are people of the Resurrection!

As we approach the end of the calendar year, and more importantly, as we reach the end of our Church year, during the month of November through its liturgy the Church leads us to reflect on our mortality and to remember sisters and brothers who have gone before us.

We do miss our relatives and friends who have died; as human beings we grieve when we look around and can no longer enjoy the presence of those we have loved and who have loved us. We often also feel saddened at the thought that we too one day have to depart this place.

Although we grieve, we remind ourselves that for us who believe, death is not the end but the beginning of life; at the moment of death 'life is changed not ended!' We know that in Jesus Christ, God became human so that he could talk to us about the Father and invite us to live the life of God. When we love we already participate in God who is love, and when we die, we share more fully in the divine love that is God.

When we remember our departed sisters and brothers we pray for them knowing that they live forever in God. We pray that they may be purified so that they can enjoy the fullness of God's love and peace. St Paul reminds us that we are here on a pilgrimage, walking towards our home in God; 'our true homeland is in heaven!' Although the pain of death stays with us and we feel the pain of being separated from those whom we have loved, we grieve certain in our hope that one day we too will be with God.

The prophet Isaiah compares the presence of God to a rich banquet with an abundance of foods and fine wines, a celebration of love in and with God. For us who are still on the journey, the Eucharistic meal of the Body and Blood of Christ unites us with this great celebration.

Let us continue celebrating our sisters and brothers especially each time we gather for our Sunday Mass as a parish community!
