25/26 November 2017 OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST, KING OF THE UNIVERSE

Dear parishioners, visitors and friends,

This Sunday brings us to the conclusion of the Church Liturgical Year, we celebrate this with the feast of Jesus Christ as Lord of the Universe, a very appropriate way to end another year.

Life is a journey and our Christian life is a pilgrimage. Our role in life is to continue to grow in our faith and trust in Jesus Christ. As we listen to the stories in the gospels and reflect on them year after year, like true disciples, we are invited to develop our personal relationship with Christ. At the end of our journey we are expected to be able to declare Jesus as the one and only Lord of our life.

Through our Church liturgical celebrations, each year we repeat this same pilgrimage and journey until we come to the moment when we have to face Jesus face to face. That is the most important moment of our life and at that moment we are invited to stand in front of our king and declare him to be truly our Lord and our God. Our liturgical year is our training ground in preparation for this moment.

In today's gospel Jesus reminds us of our need to reach out to the poor and needy in our midst. Pope Francis tells us that the surest way of meeting Christ is in the poor. Jesus calls blessed those who have fed the hungry, clothed the naked and visited the sick and those in prison and invites them into his happiness. Do I find time to reach out to those who need me?

In our parish community our St Vincent de Paul conference members regularly visit the poor, our Heidelcare volunteers offer assistance to the elderly and the Austin visitors support the sick in our hospitals. These are opportunities for all of us to help.
