9th / 10th December 2017 - Second Sunday of Advent

Dear parishioners, visitors and friends,

Prepare the way for the Lord! Make straight his paths!

On this second Sunday of Advent we meet John the Baptist out in the wilderness, preaching a time of repentance. Mark's description of the Baptist links him to the prophet Elijah and his preaching is described using words from the prophet Isaiah. John is in the company of the great prophets of the Old Testament!

Like Elijah and Isaiah before him, John is speaking about the coming of the messiah. In the past the people of God had often been encouraged to 'prepare the way' for the Lord's coming. In the ancient world conquering empires made sure that they could easily transport their armies to every part of their empire as swiftly as possible. To achieve this they straightened roads and wherever possible flattened hills and filled up valleys. This is the image used by Isaiah and John; the Lord, the messiah is now coming and he needs to be able to advance as quickly as possible.

In order to prepare myself for the coming of the messiah in my own life, I need to make sure nothing stands in the way. I need to repent and change my ways so that they will be open and welcoming. In the time of the Baptist, baptism by water was the accepted way to express a willingness to repent. The person's sins that were standing in the way were washed away.

At my own Baptism I too have been washed (immersed) in the Holy Spirit. The same Spirit of God helps me prepare myself to meet the messiah every day of my life. Prayer and reaching out to Jesus in the poor and those less fortunate are good ways to prepare myself.

As Christmas approaches how can I better prepare myself for the coming Lord? Do I spend time reflecting on the Lord's presence in my life? Do I reach out to Jesus in the poor around me?


