Dear Parishioners, Friends and Visitors

The Catholic Church in Australia as an institution

The Church, being both human and divine, is made up of all the baptised; those who believe in Jesus Son of God. The administration of the body of the Catholic Church is entrusted to the Church as institution, made up of those appointed to take up positions of leadership. Recently in the media it has been implied that the institutional Church in Australia is one big body, or that it acts as one body.

In Catholic Church in Australia is made up of 33 different dioceses, each with a bishop or archbishop at its leader. Bishops acts independently of each other, answerable directly to the pope. There are 27 territorial dioceses, like the Melbourne Archdiocese, and 7 personal dioceses, like the military ordinariate; personal dioceses extend over the whole of Australia.

The Church also includes a number of religious orders, groups of women and men dedicated to the service of the Church, each with their own leadership and special charism. Some examples we may be familiar with are the Sisters of Mercy, the Marist Brothers and the Jesuits. While these religious orders minister to the Church here in Australia, and have to respect the instructions given by the bishop of the diocese, they too are answerable to the pope. Each diocese and each religious order are permitted to own property. Dioceses are further divided into parishes, each of which are responsible for their own property, held in trust by the diocese.

The Australian bishops together form a conference (ACBC) which elects one of its members as president for two years. Archbishop Hart is presently the president of this conference. The president may at times speak in the name of all the bishops of Australia, but he has no authority over any of the other dioceses

When we speak about the Church and the institutional Church, we need to have an understanding of these different realities.
