Philippines Mission Immersion Trip—January 2019

A few weeks ago our parish council decided to donate the money from the 2017 gold coin collection to the Kabataan (youth) Orchestra. The orchestra was created a few years ago by a missionary priest working in a poorer area of the Philippines, as a way of offering a new vision to the young people in his parish community.

I have been very fortunate to visit this parish in Bataan province a number of times, and in 2013 I spent three months working among these young people.

It is not easy to share the experience of living among these people and to understand their way of life. The best way to do this is to actually visit the parish and spend time in this environment.

As a parish council it is our hope that our relationship with this parish develops further and this becomes another ministry in our parish. We discussed the possibility of inviting a group of parishioners to spend some time in the Philippines and visit this parish.

At this stage we are asking for expressions of interest. The initial group will be made up of ten people over the age of 18. We are aiming at spending 10 to 15 days in the Philippines in the second half of January 2019. Cost, excluding spending money, is around \$2,000, including travel, food and lodging.

This can be another way of reaching out beyond our parish boundaries.
