Dear Parishioners, Friends and Visitors

'As soon as you are really alone, you are with God,' Thomas Merton (1956)

This Sunday we celebrate the great event in our history when God the Holy Spirit was given to the apostles and to us. This day marks the birth day of the Church; it is the day when the apostles came of age and set out on their mission of proclaiming the good news of Jesus Christ.

On Christmas day each year we celebrate the moment in the life of humanity when God himself was born among us as Jesus, son of Mary. In Jesus, God the Son 'pitched his tent' in our midst and lived our daily life as one of us. (Jn 1:14)

We often tend to think that the story of God among us stopped with the Ascension of Jesus to the Father; but Jesus told his apostles that he would be sending the Spirit of God to dwell in us. Pentecost marks this moment when God the Spirit took up residence in each one of us. For us Christians we mark this moment in as special way when we are baptised and confirmed, and each time we participate in the sacraments.

God lives in me! When I stop to pray, I can reach into myself to touch God who journeys with me. When I am alone, I am with God. Paul tells us that we are temples of the Holy Spirit (1Co 6:19); the Spirit within us teaches us to pray (Rm 8:26). This is great news! Even here on earth I already live the life of God through God's Spirit within me!

Let us often remember God who journeys with us.

St John Paul II reminded us that 'the witness to Christ borne even to the shedding of blood has become a common inheritance of Catholics, Orthodox, Anglicans and Protestants.' ...martyrs are 'a heritage which speaks more powerfully than all the causes of division.' (Gaudete et Exsultate, 9)
