- Upgrade sound system in St Anthony's Hall


FAITH:

OUR PRECARIOUS FINANCIAL SITUATION

STEWARDSHIP INCOME

- Is the major source of parish income
- It should be able to fund basic parish operating expenditure
- Currently averaging \$1,950 per week from envelopes & direct payments

THE REALITY

- Our Stewardship Income is insufficient to meet weekly operating costs so we currently rely heavily on additional unsecured sources of income, i.e. loose plate, rentals, donations etc. to help meet these expenses
- Additionally, we have been forced to turn to Investment Income (\$235,000 in last 2 years) to meet essential repairs & maintenance
- This situation MUST be addressed

OUR STEWARDSHIP INCOME CHALLENGE

To increase Stewardship Income from \$1,950 per week to a min. \$2,750 per week

- Those that have less give less those that have more give more


