THE JOY OF SUNDAY

St Anthony's Parish Bulletin begins a new series of articles this weekend, drawn from YOUCAT. We focus on Sunday—the Lord's Day: a day filled with the joy of Our Lord's Resurrection, a day made holy by our participation in Sunday Mass, a day which fills the week with the sweet perfume of the Word of God, the Eucharist, and the People of God gathered for prayer, worship and

During Lent, let's build up the habit of weekly Mass. Let's all aim to arrive at the church even a few minutes before Mass begins to "rest in the Lord", to become settled, peaceful, ready. "The Eucharist unfolds in two great parts which together form one single act of worship" (Compendium n.277)

We receive Holy Communion either on the tongue or in the hand. The priest invites us "The Body of Christ". We respond "Amen". This is an act of faith. We present our hands as a throne for the King of kings—the left hand on top of the right. We pick up the host with our right hand and place it on our tongue. When we hold a child, or keys or a handkerchief, it is best to receive Holy Communion on the tongue. We receive Holy Communion straight away, before returning to our seat.
