THE LORD'S PRAYER: THE OUR FATHER

If the Father is in heaven", where is that heaven?

We should not look for heaven above the clouds. Wherever we turn to God in his glory and to our neighbor in his need; wherever we experience the joys of love; whenever we convert and allow ourselves to be reconciled with God, *heaven opens there*. "Not that God is where heaven is, but rather heaven is where God is". (Gerhard Ebeling).

What does it mean to say, "Hallowed be thy name"?

To "hallow" in Sacred Scripture indicates the true nature of a person. To hallow God's name means to do justice to his reality, to acknowledge him, to praise him, to give him due honor, and to live according to his commandments.

What does it mean to say, "Thy kingdom come"?

When we pray, "Thy kingdom come", we call for Christ to come again, as he promised, and for God's reign, which has already begun here on earth, to prevail definitively. Francois Fenelon says, "To will everything that God wills, and to will it always, in all circumstances and without reservations: that is the kingdom of God which is entirely within."

What does it mean to say, "Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven"?

When we pray for the universal accomplishment of God's will, we pray that on earth and in our own heart it may become as it already is in heaven.

As long as we continue to set our hearts on our own plans, our will, and our ideas, earth cannot become heaven. One person wants this, the other that. We find our happiness, however, when together we want what God wills. Praying means making room bit by bit for God's will on this earth.
