• Pope Francis has announced that BI Cardinal John Henry Newman is to be canonized later this year (1892—1975). Cardinal Joseph Mindszenty has been proclaimed 'Venerable". Cardinal Newman (1801—1890) is perhaps the most renowned Anglican convert to Catholicism. A theologian, poet and writer, Newman was beatified in 2010. Cardinal Mindszenty is a hero of the 20th century and a champion of the people of Hungary in his resistance to Soviet Communism, including long imprisonment, house arrest and exile.

• Pope Francis has called presidents of Bishops' Conferences and other church leaders to Rome this weekend to address clergy sexual abuse.

What is "blessing"?

The prayer of blessing is our response to God's gifts: we bless the Almighty who first blesses us and fills us with his gifts.

How can adoration be defined?

Adoration is the humble acknowledgement by human beings that they are creatures of the thrice-holy Creator.

What are the different forms of the prayer of petition?

It can be a petition for pardon or also a humble and trusting petition for all our needs either spiritual or material. The first thing to ask for, however, is the coming of the Kingdom.
