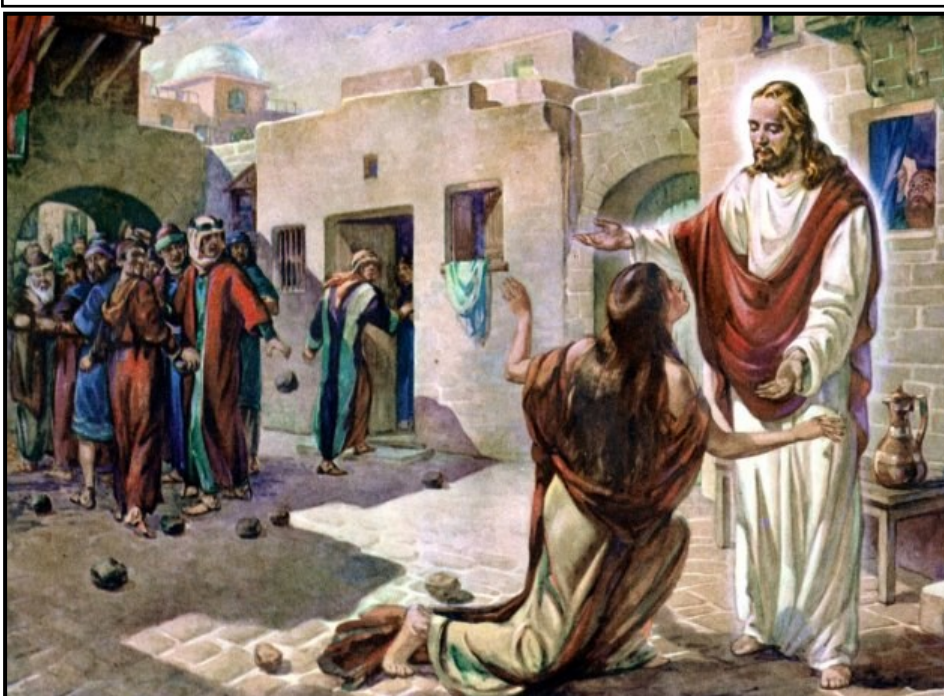

## 5<sup>th</sup> Lenten Sunday, Year C

**Woman, caught in adultery**

Dear brothers and sisters in Jesus,

It was a blessing in disguise that on that day as the Pharisees were taking the adulterous woman to be stoned to death, that they also planned to trap Jesus. They brought the woman to Jesus not intending to save her, but to find fault with Jesus as well. But Jesus turned that occasion around to make it an opportunity to give the woman 'life-saving blessing', and to the Pharisees the grace to repent of their sins.

The Pharisees planned much harm to Jesus and to the woman, but Jesus makes that into a great blessing to the woman and to the Pharisees.

In Rom. 5:20 we read, "Where sin abounds, there grace super abounds". Is that not too good of God? It's so great of God that he makes us walk straight even on crooked paths. None of us can fully grasp all that is meant by those words, 'where sin abounds, there grace super abounds'.

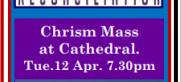

And what about those Pharisees; what would have become of them? They would not have known 'repentance', nor 'forgiveness', but rather they too would have eventually died in their mortal sins.

That day the amazing grace of God changed their lives for good. That day even the Pharisees took the words of Jesus seriously and acknowledged their sinfulness.

Jesus was not taking a risk of getting the woman stoned when he said that any sinless person could throw the first stone at her. Jesus had already put into them the true sorrow for their sins. His grace of repentance was already at work in them all.

Let us also come to the presence of Jesus and know how his grace super abounds in our lives. Let's bring other to him, as well.
