THE RITE OF RECONCILIATION

1. *In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.*
2. Priest welcomes you and says a prayer
3. *Father it is ... weeks/months/years since my last Confession and these are my sins ...*
4. Priest talks to you and then assigns a penance (prayer or act to do in the Church after Confession)
5. **Act of Contrition**
(a) *"O my God, I am very sorry that I have sinned against you. Because you are so good and with your help, I will not sin again".*
(b) *Lord Jesus, Son of God, have mercy on me, a sinner.*
6. The Priest will grant you Absolution and the forgiveness of your sins.
7. Priest: The Lord has freed you from your sins; go in peace.
Person: *Thanks be to God. Thank you, Father.*
