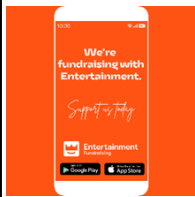

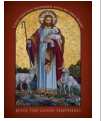

## 4th Sunday of Easter, Year B, Good Shepherd Sunday: Vocation Sunday!



Dear brothers and sisters in the Risen Lord!

Jesus, by his words and example, has proved that he is truly our Good Shepherd. He said, "The Good Shepherd lays down his life for the sheep." We know that Jesus, in caring for us, laid down his own life; and then having risen to new life he still cares for us. There is none like Jesus who can be called "The Good Shepherd"

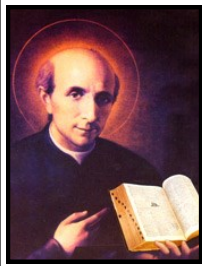
By calling Jesus as our Good Shepherd, we also imply that we are his "sheep". Though, in many respects we are unlike the sheep, in many other respects, we are like the sheep. Sheep are weak animals. They, being prey animals, are also defenceless. Left alone, the sheep cannot survive. The sheep need a shepherd to care for them and to protect them: So do we. In saying this we do not mean to under-estimate our abilities, nor deny our self-esteem.

No one can deny that in spite of our manifold abilities, health, wealth and intellectual capabilities our existence heavily depends on God. In fact, everything that we need to sustain our lives come from God. Therefore, on this Good Shepherd Sunday, we acknowledge God's role in the life of everyone, and express our gratitude.

Though we are compared to weak and defenceless sheep, we are called to be like "Leader-Sheep". Leader-sheep are a special breed of sheep found mostly in Iceland. They have the intuitive quality of sensing the danger in advance. Whether the danger is from predators or an avalanche or bad weather, the 'leader-sheep' get to know the impending danger and quickly lead the rest of the flock and the shepherd to safety. Despite our inadequacies, we are called to be like the leader-sheep in one way another.



Whatever may be our state of life, we are to lead and protect each other. For this reason Good Shepherd Sunday is also called Vocation Sunday. 'Vocation' means 'being called'. We are being called to care for one another in the name of Jesus, our Good Shepherd.



Today, 21st of April 2024 marks 229th Birthday of St Vincent Pallotti. He answered the call from God to serve his fellow humans in the best way possible. The circumstances were inadequate, but Vincent answered the call and proved to be "a good shepherd" after Jesus "The Good Shepherd".

St Vincent Pallotti encourages us to be good apostles and work towards realising the dream of everyone becoming "One fold under One Shepherd".
