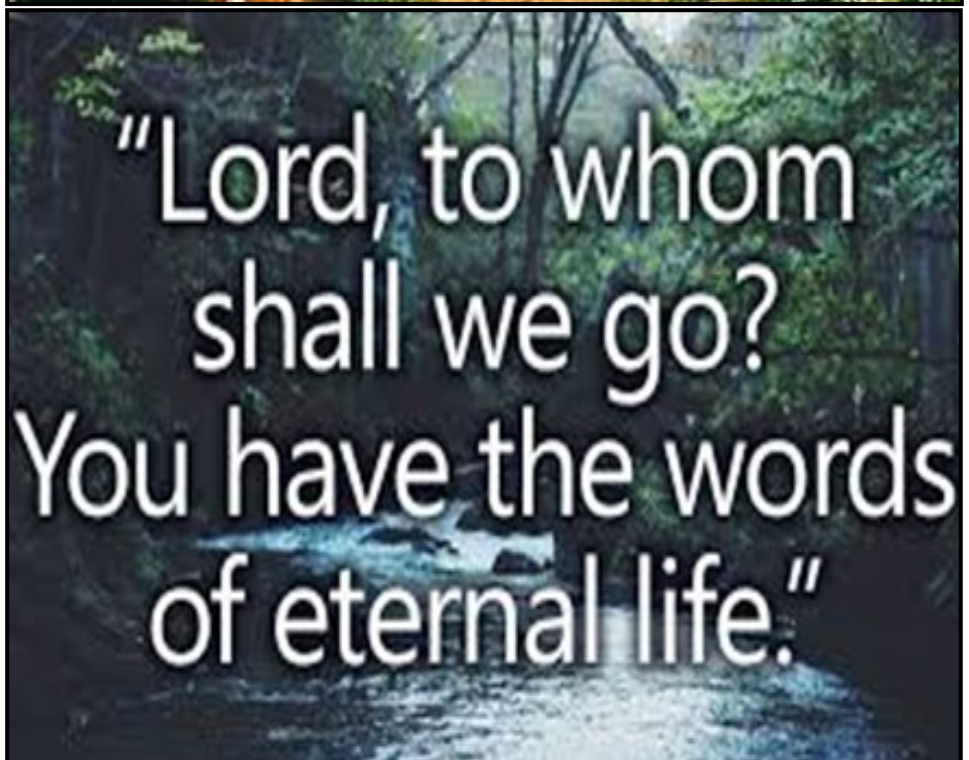
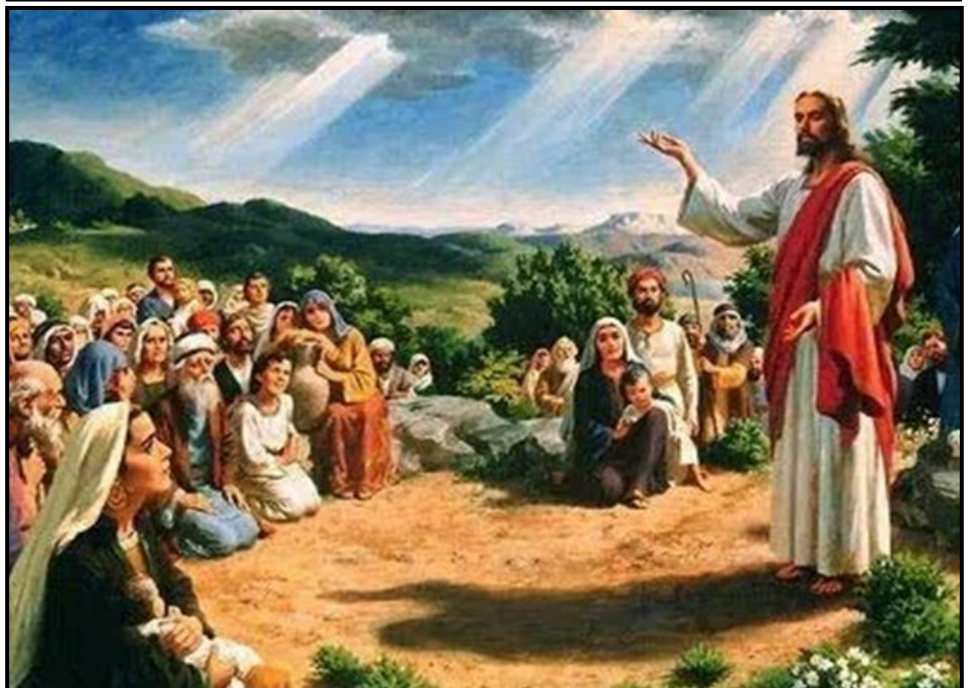

Lord to whom can we go?



Dear brothers and sisters in Jesus,

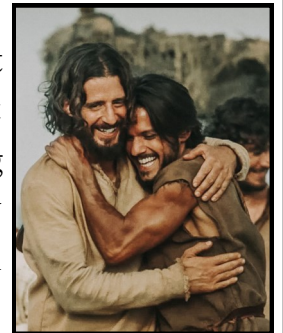
“Lord, to whom shall we go? This is not a question, though it sounds like one; nor is it a desperate plea from Peter asking Jesus to recommend some one else for them to follow. Rather, this is an expression of Peter’s firm decision. Peter and his companions won’t be shaken by the leaving of many other followers of Jesus. He knows for sure that there is no one else but Jesus who they could fearlessly belong to. In other words, Peter and his companions have decided to stay, no matter what.

Like Peter, how many of us can sincerely declare Jesus to be the only person we follow? Were there times when you thought of abandoning Jesus? If you never even once thought of leaving Jesus, what is it that holds you close to him? Peter had recognised in Jesus the words of eternal life; and that was the reason for his firm decision to stay with Jesus.

Peter and his companions did not always understand the full meaning of every word that Jesus spoke, but those were for them life giving words. The words of Jesus were already making a big change in their lives. So, knowingly or unknowingly they had accepted Jesus to be their bread of life and their life giving word. What about us? Do we need to look for some one else other than Jesus?

Lord Jesus, there are times I do not understand you. I know I needn’t have to understand everything in order to follow you, yet at times I get carried away. I trust in you even when I can’t see where you are leading me. Thank you Lord, for trusting me, even when I seem to walk away from you. Speak to my heart as you did speak to your disciples. Enlighten my heart to believe there is no one else on whom I can rely on.
