Catholic Education

During the week it was announced that from 2019, St Anthony's and St Aloysius' schools will be amalgamated, offering P-6 classes on two campuses. This decision was reached after consultation with the Archbishop of Melbourne, Catholic Education Melbourne, St Aloysius School families, and a Working Party, convened by Catholic Education Melbourne. Commencing with school year 2019, Mrs Margaret Carlei, Principal, St Anthony's will also administer St Aloysius School. St Aloysius will retain its own name and school uniform.

A local working party will meet to determine the many aspects of this amalgamation. This is good news for all who have worked to keep the doors of St Aloysius School open.

Maintenance Collection

Council rates and AGL electricity bills are due 30/9/18. Quarterly rates for parish properties including St Anthony's Presbytery, Parish House, St Anthony's Church and St Anthony's Hall total \$2,101. AGL electricity totals \$714. As we reflect on parish expenses it is worth noting that income from hire of St Anthony's Hall and the Glen does not presently meet the costs of electricity and gas. This needs to be reviewed, so that we are not running at a loss in areas which should be helping our parish.

From Archbishop Comensoli

Looking ahead, it falls to me, as your Archbishop, to ensure that our local Church in Melbourne is unequivocally committed to attending to the harm done, prioritising the dignity and care of all who are young and vulnerable, rebuilding trust among our people, and creating safe environments in our communities. agencies and organisations. This is the way of Jesus Christ. It must be my way. And I invite you to join with me in making it our common Gospel way. I want to let you know that I am committed to exercising my responsibilities according to the framework offered by the Child Safe Standards articulated by the Royal Commission. I am also committed to working closely with the Commission for Children and Young People here in Victoria to implement policies and processes within the Archdiocese that comply with best practice. The Archdiocese has signed up to the National Redress Scheme, and we will join with national Church actions in response to the recommendations of the Royal Commission. In the two weeks since taking office as Archbishop, I have initiated a process of appraisal into our current policies, processes and structures to identify what further action can be taken to improve our transparency, compassion and accountability. I am strongly committed to reporting to the appropriate authorities, and have already exercised that duty here in Melbourne. I am also strongly committed to upholding the seal of confession. I have begun conversations with our public authorities about finding a way in which these two principles can be upheld, for the sake of the safety of all.
