MEDITATION

Love for the poor must be in every age the distinguishing mark of Christians. The poor deserve not just a few alms; they have a claim to justice. For Christians there is a special obligation to share their goods. Our example in love for the poor is Christ. "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven" - that is the first sentence of Jesus' Sermon on the Mount. There is material, emotional, intellectual, and spiritual poverty. Christians must look after the needy of this earth with great consideration, love, and perseverance. After all, on no other point will they be evaluated by Christ so decisively as on their way of treating the poor: "As you did it to one of the least of these my brethren, you did it to me".

They practice the 12 Steps of AA, by welcoming and giving comfort to families of alcoholics, and by giving understanding and encouragement to the alcoholic. A central pillar of Al-Anon is anonymity. This is fundamental to creating a safe place for people to share their stories without fear of judgement. Listening to other peoples stories helps you realise your problems are not unique and that you are not alone. Attending Al-Anon meetings is free of charge. A small voluntary contribution covers rent and refreshments
