Ordinary Sunday A 17 The True Treasure

<u>Dear brothers and sisters in Jesus.</u> We all do shopping now and then. There are times when we come across some new items in the shops. Some of those items may not attract us so much, so we by pass them. But some of them might attract us and we would like to take a closer look at them. We might even think of buying them.



We find asking ourselves a few questions; like, "Is this item useful for me or do I really need it? How much does it cost? Can I afford to pay the price?" Then we make calculations and find that, only if I forgo something else that I would be able to buy that item. Then we ask yet another question. "Is it worth the cost?" If so, we end up buying the item, even if we have to forgo everything else in our shopping list.

In today's Gospel, Jesus is advising us to keep asking similar questions and decide to achieve those things that are of greater importance. If need be, we might even need to forgo things of lesser importance. Today's first parable tells us of a man who stumbled upon a buried treasure. It was by mere chance, that he came across the treasure. In the second parable, the merchant was constantly on a search for pearls of great value.

We should be always looking for things of great value, matters of eternal value; we cannot wait for our luck or chance. Matters concerning our soul for example, cannot be left to chance. We have to do anything and everything in order to make sure that we do find the most important treasure or pearl for our soul.

Whether we stumbled upon Jesus, like the treasure in the field, or found him after a long search, no matter, if we have Jesus, we must see that we do not lose him. This may mean that we will have to forgo a lot other things. Having Jesus and following him sincerely would surely come at a cost .It will place demands on our hearts, our minds, our souls and our bodily desires The big question is not how much it will cost us, but rather how much we will gain. What Jesus offers us is worth any price.

Jesus is our True Treasure! But for Jesus, we are his true treasure, whom he bought back at a great price on the cross.

Something for us to think about.
