

Safeguarding Children and Young People


All children and young people who come to our parish have a right to feel and be safe.

15TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME, Year B Our Mission

Dear all, The Gospel of this Sunday reminds me of something from my Seminary days. It was in 1983 that a group of people from afar came to share our seminary facilities for their 5 day retreat. We seminarians were not given to participate in the



retreat, but on the final day of the retreat, we were given some time to listen to their stories.

I remember them speaking about their experiences of 4th day of the retreat, when the retreat master had sent them out into the near by village in pairs. He had instructed them to keep walking until someone stopped them. The retreat master also had appointed a few of the participants to stay back in the seminary-chapel to keep praying for those sent out. It was a half day 'practicals' for them.

One pair of the participants shared as to how they were stopped by some stranger on the road and were asked to introduce themselves, and then they were invited into their home to pray over a bedridden member of the family. Another pair had a wonderful experience of being asked to tell them more about Jesus. And yet another pair had the opportunity to listen to some one's tearful story and then to comfort them and pray over them. Thus each and every pair had some similar amazing experience of witnessing Christ and his love to people who were hungry for truth, love and care.

The retreat master then told us that this sort of experience could always be seen wherever he had been to preach similar retreats. He also told us that the success of those who had been sent out in pairs very much depended on the group who had stayed back to pray for those sent out.

Dear all, everyone is not expected to be out there in the far away mission-fields to preach Christ, yet by our Baptism each and every one of us is given the task of preaching Christ in one way or another. The above story shows us that 'praying' is one of the greatest of contributions that anyone could make towards the success of the missionary works

In addition to 'praying', our exemplary lives also help spread the Gospel. And always remember that unseen to us there are many missionaries, social workers and a good number of faithful lay volunteers spending their lives in reaching out to those hungry for the Truth. They are in the mission fields on our behalf too. *Fr. Leenus.*
