## 16TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME, Year B

### Action, Reflection, Action

Dear all,

This Sunday's Gospel is a follow-up from last Sunday. If last Sunday was the launching of an "Action", this Sunday Jesus is calling his disciples for a time of "Reflection". Surprisingly, even before a proper 'reflection' could take place, there follows yet another "Action." As we all know "Action, Reflection, Action" is a method very many people follow for an effective way of living.

Jesus had earlier sent his disciples off, two by two, on a mission with clear instructions. Today, they have returned to report to Jesus as to how it all went. As good disciples they had "learned", and then as good apostles they had "taught", and now Jesus as a good Master and Shepherd wants them to come away and take a deep breath, before they can leap for a much greater mission.

But immediately then they realise that time for a deep breath is a luxury when so many people are looking for something far more precious than that. If the disciples needed time to spend with Jesus, so also the multitude. Each and everyone, you and me too, need Jesus more than we need our breath.

Jesus himself often took time off to refresh himself, spending time alone with his Father. Being busy with his Father's business, did not stand in the way of him spending some quiet time with his Father. Action that does not allow us for a time of reflection, can be dangerous. So also reflection that does not lead us to further action, would be meaningless.

The disciples of Jesus have proved themselves to be good apostles. They are in great demand now. In fact, instead of the disciples having to look for new followers, more and more people were seeking the disciples. The good news is that the people were not seeking the disciples only, but much more seeking Jesus, the source of all that is good.

But, unfortunately this resulted in Jesus and his disciples having no time for the much needed 'Reflection'. At this, Jesus could have reacted with frustration. But, no, instead he is moved with compassion for the people, whom he sees as leaderless people. Jesus quickly gets ready to launch yet another Action as we shall see next weekend. *Adapted by Fr.
