OUR PARISH SCHOOL

- The Relic of St Anthony came to St Antho ny's Parish and school to inspire everyone by their beauty. The relics included a small fragment of skin and another vessel contained a piece of body mass of St. Anthony. Both were displayed in a magnificent casing, one within the statue and the other in a cylindrical tube. The students were engaged in the homily given by Fr Mario Conte from Padua, who was visiting with the relic. The students and staff were able to connect with Saint Anthony by 'venerating' or touching the statue. Everyone was given a prayer card of St. Anthony with a prayer. The visit of the relics of St. Anthony will be remembered for a long time.
- On Saturday 1 June Year 3/4 students participated at 6pm Saturday Vigil Mass at St Anthony's Church. The students and their families, along with teachers and staff, attended Mass on the feast of the Ascension of the Lord. This feast commemorates the Ascension of Jesus into heaven to be seated at the right hand of the Father.

 Confirmation Information Evening was held on Tuesday 4 June 7pm in the Padua Pavilion.
