#### MEDITATION

God gives himself a name so as to make it possible to address him. God does not wish to remain incognito. He does not want to be revered as a "high being" that is merely sensed or surmised. God wishes to be known and to be called upon as someone real and active. In the burning bush God reveals to Moses his holy name: YHWH (Ex 3:14). God makes it possible for his people to address him, but he still remains the hidden God, the present mystery. Out of reverence for God, the name of God was not (and is not) spoken in Israel; the title *Adonai* (Lord) is substituted. This same word is used by the New Testament when it glorified Jesus as true God: "Jesus is Lord!" (Rom 10:9).

The Joy of Sunday

Why do Christians replace the Sabbath with Sunday? Christians replaced the celebration of the Sabbath with the celebration of Sunday because Jesus Christ rose from the dead on a Sunday. The "Lord's Day", however, does include elements of the Sabbath.

The Christian Sunday has three essential elements:

1. It recalls the creation of the world and communicates the festive splendour of God's goodness to the passage of time.

2. It recalls the "eighth day of creation", when the world was made new in Christ

3. It includes the theme of rest, not just to sanctify the interruption of work, but to point even now toward mankind's eternal rest in God. YOUCAT n.364
