Palm Sunday of the Passion of Our Lord, Year B

Dear brothers and sisters in Jesus,

Today is a joyful day as well as a sorrowful one. We express its joyful aspect and call it "Palm Sunday" and express its sorrowful aspect and call it "Passion Sunday". On the one hand, it is with great gladness that today we commemorate the joyful entry of Jesus into the City of Jerusalem; on the other hand, today we are invited to feel one with Jesus in his sufferings and agony.



Again, on the one hand, Jesus found it very appropriate that the people joyfully welcome him; on the other hand he himself was weeping. He approved of their jubilations in his honour. Jesus found it fitting that the people spread their garments and tree branches on his way, wave palm leaves and shout out Hosanna. Jesus appreciated all these, that is why he said, if the people kept silent then the very stones would be shouting out Hosanna to him.

So then, what made him weep that day? Amidst all the joyful atmosphere, why was Jesus so sorrowful? Was he anticipating his terrible death? I believe the reason for his sorrow was the hard-heartedness of the people. He knew that their expression of welcome was not a whole-hearted acceptance of him. All these would soon be turning into rejection and hatred. Soon the shouts of Hosanna will be replaced by shouts of 'Crucify Him'.

What was once true of the people of Jerusalem is probably true also of us in our own times. The Palm Sunday/Passion Sunday, painfully makes us aware of our own divided hearts, and double-mindedness. We remember how quickly the enthusiasm of Jerusalem crowd evaporated. We realise how quickly we too fluctuate in our enthusiasm and commitments.

Very many are the times and occasions when we joyfully welcome Jesus into our lives. We praise him, thank him, adore him and make promises to him. But in no time we take U turns and reject him, neglect him, discard him, deny and even betray him. Knowingly or unknowingly we move from one extreme to the other.

Jesus on the other hand is always 'for us'. Never ever did he change sides; he never made compromises; never looked for his own advantages. He was firm in his mission. Cross was his aim, our salvation was his purpose. And nothing and no-one could ever stop him from accomplishing it. During these days of the Holy Week, in response to His unconditional love and mercy, let us make an extra effort, with the grace of God, to draw closer to Jesus as He draws closest to us.
