### CORONA VIRUS

Acting on the advice of the Australian and Victorian Departments of Health Archbishop Comensoli proposes the following:

- Holy Communion may be received only with the Sacred Host
- Ministers of Holy Communion must sanitize their hands before and after Holy Communion
- People may prefer to exchange the Sign of Peace with a smile or a bow and the usual greeting "the Peace of Christ"
- Holy Communion is received either on the tongue or with the left hand placed over the right hand as a throne for the King of kings. The minister invites us "the Body of Christ" and we respond "Amen". Please consume the host straight away before returning to your seat.

### WEEKDAY MASS

Daily Mass is generally celebrated Tuesday—Saturday 9.15am at St Anthony's Church. Any change in the Mass schedule is advertised in the calendar box in St Anthony's Parish Bulletin. Please note that the school side entry of St Anthony's Church is closed on school days. This will provide for the safety and security of our school children. Please enter St Anthony's Church via the main doors or Grange Road.

St Anthony's School advises that anyone requiring access to school grounds during school hours (8am—4pm) must first register at St Anthony's School Office.

### OFFERINGS FOR MASS

The practice of giving an offering dates back to the early Church when the faithful brought bread and wine for the Mass and other gifts for the support of the priest and for the poor. Nowadays a Mass offering is a way for the donor to join themselves to the Sacrifice of the Mass. Mass can be offered for personal intentions, the welfare of the living and eternal life for those who have died. Mass offering envelopes are available in the porches of St Anthony's Church and can be placed in the weekend collection.

### ST ANTHONY'S PARISH STEWARDSHIP MIDWAY REVIEW

MEDITATION

The Father wanted to reveal the divine glory of his Son even during Jesus' earthly life. Christ's Transfiguration was meant to help the disciples later to understand his death and Resurrection. Three Gospels relate how Jesus, on the mountaintop, begins to shine (is "transfigured") before the eyes of his disciples. The voice of his heavenly Father calls Jesus his "beloved Son", to whom they are supposed to listen. Peter would like to "make three booths" and capture the moment. Jesus, however, is on the way that leads to suffering. The vision of glory is only to strengthen his disciples.
