Ascension of the Lord Year A

Readings: Acts of the Apostles 1:1-11; Ephesians 1:17-23; Matthew 28:16-20

Holy Gospel

The eleven disciples set out for Galilee, to the mountain where Jesus had arranged to meet them. When they saw him they fell down before him, though some hesitated. Jesus came up and spoke to them. He said, 'All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go, therefore, make disciples of all nations; baptise them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teach them to observe all the commands I gave you. And look, I am with you always; yes, to the end of time.'

Meditation

Jesus Christ, Lord glorified on high,
Look with love upon your brothers and sisters on earth.
Your ascension is the hope of our future glory,
and your presence near your Father
announces our own entrance into the eternal welling.
Let the desire for heavenly realities
not make us neglect our work on earth.
Let our hope for the future
inspire in us a respect for the present moment.
Let your ascension into heaven move us
to make your glory dwell on earth.
Make us witnesses to your presence
among our brothers and sisters until the end of time.

Jesus Christ is Lord of the world and Lord of history because everything was made for his sake. All men were redeemed by him and will be judged by him. He is over us, and the only One to whom we bend the knee in worship: he is with us as Head of his Church, in which the kingdom of God begins even now; he is ahead of us as Lord of history, in whom the powers of darkness are definitively overcome and the destinies of the world are brought to perfection according to God's plan; he comes to meet us in glory, on a day we do not know, to renew and perfect the world. We can experience his nearness especially in God's Word, in the reception of the Sacraments, in caring for the poor, and wherever "two or three are gathered in my name".

Even Christ cannot help someone who does not want to know anything about love; such a person judges himself.

Because Jesus Christ is "the way, and the truth, and the life". He will show what is of lasting value in God's sight and what is not. Held up to the standard of his life, the full truth about all people, things, thoughts, and events will come to light.

Prayer to our Lady Help of Christians

Under the title of Help of Christians, Mary was chosen as Patroness of Australia by the First Provincial Synod, convened by Archbishop John Bede Polding, in Sydney in 1844. The fledgling colonies needed Mary's help at that time, as the nation does today.

We are helped through Mary's powerful intercession, and through the example of her life that we find in the Gospels.

O Mary, Help of Christians, in our need we turn to you with eyes of love, with empty hands and longing hearts. We look to you that we may see your Son, our Lord. We lift our hands that we may have the Bread of Life. We open wide our hearts to receive the Prince of Peace. Mother of the Church, your sons and daughters thank you for your trusting word that echoes through the ages, rising from an empty soul made full of grace, prepared by God to welcome the Word to the world that the world itself might be reborn. In you, the reign of God has dawned, a reign of grace and peace, love and justice, born from the depths of the Word made flesh. The Church throughout the world joins you in praising him whose mercy is from age to age.

Mary, Help of Christians. We fly to you today as your beloved children. We ask you to intercede for us with your Son, as you did at the wedding in Cana. Pray for us, loving Mother, and gain for our nation and world, and for all our families and loved ones, the protection of God's holy angels, that we may be spared the worst of this illness. For those already afflicted, we ask you to obtain the grace of healing and deliverance. Hear the cries of those who are vulnerable and fearful, wipe away their tears and help them to trust. In this time of trial and testing, teach all of us in the Church to love one another and to be patient and kind. Help us to bring the peace of Jesus to our land and to our hearts. We come to you with confidence, knowing that you truly are our compassionate mother, health of the sick and cause of our joy. Shelter us under the mantle of your protection, keep us in the embrace of your arms, help us always to know the love of your Son, Jesus. Amen.
