

Dear brothers and sisters in Jesus,

TALENT! What's a talent? Who doesn't know what a talent is! It's an ability, it's a gift, a natural skill, it's also a unit of money. Who doesn't have a talent? Everyone has talents of one sort or another. Australia has talent, America has talent, the whole world is full of talents; amazing talents, breath taking performances of various talents! God must be



extremely happy about the God-given talents being well used. Just like, parents are happy when their children perform well, so also every well-used talent makes God happy.

It's the lazy ones and those who misuse their talents who are to be blamed. They do not make God happy. Jesus calls us to be fully alive as maybe possible for each one according to ones abilities and circumstances. We all have to give an account regarding the use we made of our talents.

Being successful in life does not mean having to outrun everyone else. A successful person is one who puts his/her best in taking others along, so that, everyone can be a winner. Let's work on that sort of a talent, which is much appreciated by the giver of every sort of talent!
