

31st Sunday in Ordinary Time, Year A

Dear brothers and sisters in Jesus,

Today in the Gospel Jesus is throwing at us a few challenges, e.g. not to call anyone else our father except God himself. Similarly, no one else should be called a teacher but God alone. That leaves us with a dilemma.

How literally are we to take these instructions from Jesus? Are we not to call our biological parents "mother" or "father"? What are we to call our school/college teachers and professors? We are so used to calling them by the titles that suit their positions. I think that's okay with Jesus too. At the same time, Jesus wants us to take his instructions in the best spirit rather than literally. In other words, instead of seeking public recognition and personal honour, the followers of Jesus are being invited to recognise and acknowledge the supreme authority of God and to serve God and others in humility.

Any authority that may be attached to our positions in society ultimately comes from God. So, any father, mother, teacher, priest, bishop, pope, premier, prime minister, president, governor, king, queen or any one else in any position of authority is in fact acting on behalf of God. Therefore, the titles that suit the almighty creator God, strictly speaking do not suit humanity. God alone is the ultimate source of all. Therefore, by calling him alone 'Father' we can acknowledge that great truth.

Even though Jesus himself is God, one with the Father and equal with him in majesty and power, he still calls God his 'Father' and taught us to do so. That is the reason why we can call Jesus our 'brother', and that's also why we are brothers and sisters to one another in Jesus.

Mother Eugenia Elisabetta Ravasio, to whom God the Father is believed to have appeared several times, quotes a message from God the Father "All who call me by the name 'Father' even if only once, will not perish, but be sure of their eternal life..."

To him be glory, praise and honour for ever and ever"
