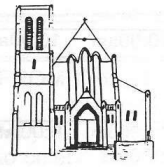

Parish Stewardship

Sincere thanks to all who participated in our Parish Stewardship Renewal. It was a time for us to consider parish life, our involvement, current finances, and to commit a new pledge. 142 pledges were received: 32 new families came on board, with a 17.5% increase in overall giving. The weekly total pledge is \$2,291, an average of \$16 per pledge. Over the last month loose giving to support our parish has averaged \$1,000. Of the 88 families at our two parish schools, only 3 families made a commitment to support parish life and mission.

Follow up includes the formation of a Parish Finance Committee to oversee parish expenditure, promote Parish Stewardship and prepare a parish finance report. We also need to look at ways that school families can also feel a part of parish life and make their contribution.

Rejoice and be Glad (Mt 5:12)

The prayerful reading of God's word, which is "sweeter than honey" (Ps 119:103) yet a "two-edged sword" (Heb 4:12), enables us to pause and listen to the voice of the Master. As the bishops of India have reminded us, "devotion to the word of God is not simply one of many devotions, beautiful but somewhat optional. It goes to the very heart and identity of Christian life. The word has the power to transform lives".

Meeting Jesus in the Scriptures leads us to the Eucharist, where the written word attains its greatest efficacy, for there the living Word is truly present. In the Eucharist, the one true God receives the greatest worship the world can give him, for it is Christ himself who is offered. When we receive him in Holy Communion, we renew our covenant with him and allow him to carry out ever more fully his work of transforming our lives.
