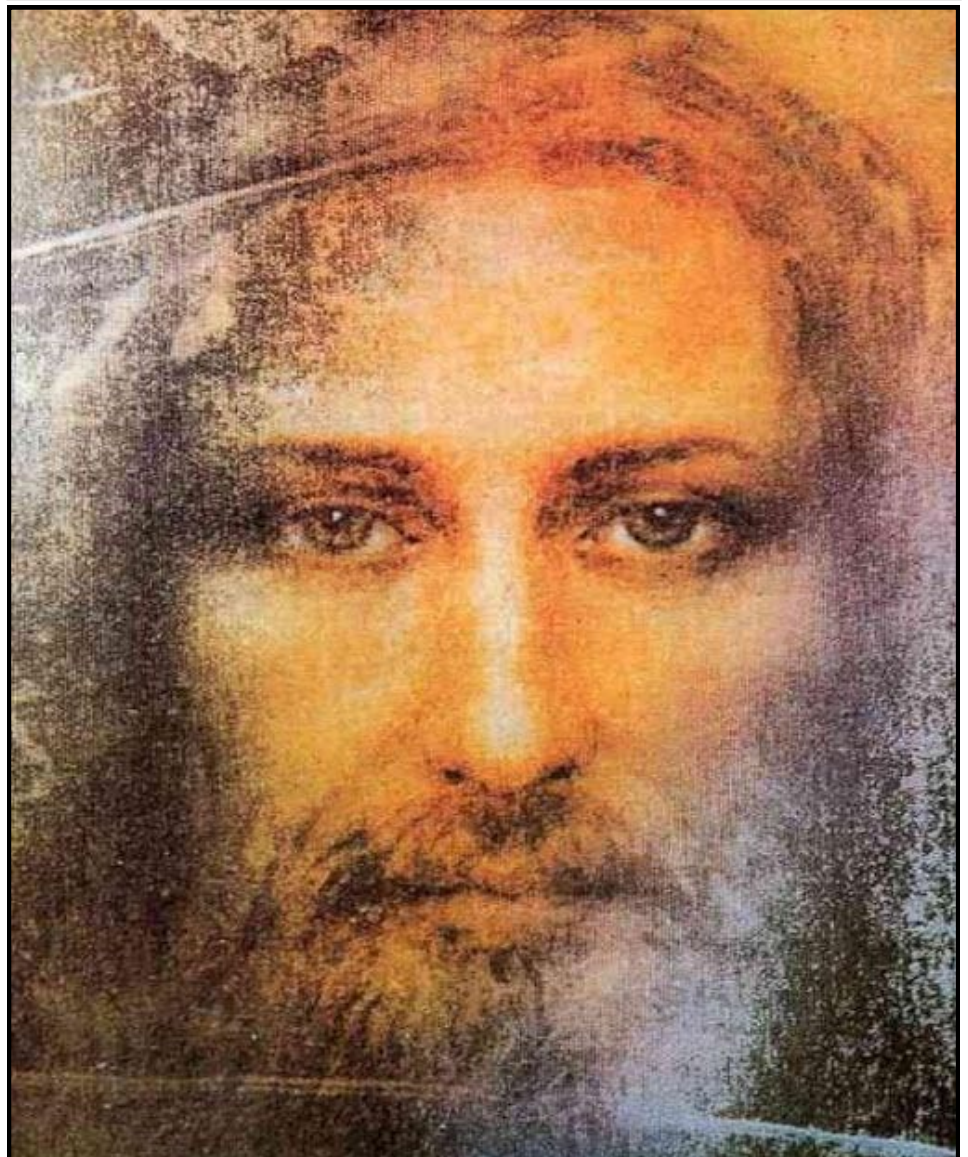

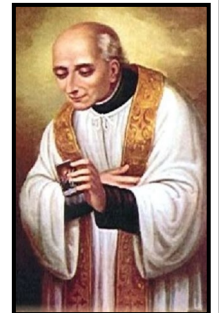

Dear Parishioners of St Anthony & St Aloysius, Glen Huntly/Caulfield

My prayerful greetings to you in the Lord.

May I first express my gratitude to your Parish Priest Fr Leenus Neetany SAC for his outstanding ongoing service to your parish community.

As you may be aware, the previous Parish Priest of St Joseph's Elsternwick and Holy Cross Caulfield South, Fr Babu (Varghese) Kattikattu Augustine MC returned to India earlier this year. I am sure you join me in wishing him every grace and blessing for the future. With his departure, we are presented with an opportunity to look closely at how best to meet the needs and interrelation of the wider faith family into the future. This is something that is happening across the breadth of the Archdiocese.

Over recent decades, as we have experienced a steady decline in active participation in parish life in some parishes coupled with a reduction in the number of ordained clergy available for parish ministry, changes in parish configuration have been undertaken. Some parishes have been partnered under the care of a single parish priest, some have been amalgamated and more recently, multiple parishes have been brought into a larger family or Mission under the care of two or more priests appointed to work together.

In the growth areas of the Archdiocese, particularly in the North and West we have very large and expanding parishes that also require the pastoral care of priests. For example, while the Parish of Glen Huntly / Caulfield serves about 3,800 Catholics, the Parish of Craigieburn serves 31,000 Catholics. (ABS Census 2021)

In order to both address the pastoral challenges and find ways to encourage vitality and growth across the whole Archdiocese, we established the process of renewal you know as Take the Way of the Gospel. This process invites us into a journey of listening, learning and walking together to reimagine our present way of doing things in the face of the changing circumstances in which we now live so that:

- The mission of the Gospel is at the heart of our life, worship and outreach;
- Local faith communities are arranged to allow them to flourish;
- Our faith communities are effectively resourced spiritually, ministerially and materially.

In the spirit of Take the Way of the Gospel, I have asked your Parish Priest, Fr Leenus Neetany SAC to take on the pastoral care of both St Joseph's Elsternwick and Holy Cross Caulfield South in addition to his role as Parish Priest of St Anthony & St Aloysius Glen Huntly / Caulfield.

He has generously and willingly agreed to take on this additional role and will be available to take up an appointment from 1 November this year.

Over the coming weeks and months, I would encourage your Parishes to commence discussions through your respective Parish Councils to determine how these shared arrangements might best be established, sacramentally and administratively. In the first place, I ask that you consider what are the needs for Sunday Mass, so that the vibrant gathering of God's household might flourish through the talents, gifts and ministerial resources among you.

Please be assured of my prayers. I wish you every blessing in the works of your Parish, and your ongoing efforts towards parish renewal into the hands of the Lord as we together walk our journey of faith.
