Our New Regional Bishop Tony Ireland has confirmed with us that on



### **Dangers of attachment to Wealth**

Dear brothers and sisters in Jesus,

I remember from my childhood days, a question my Sunday School teachers used to ask us. The question was: Who made you? We were taught to answer, God made us. Then a second question followed, Why did God make you? We were taught to answer, God made us, so that we could be happily with God for ever in heaven.



I think every word of the above answers is to be underlined as very important. In other words, Heaven is our Target. We often say, this life here on earth is a Pilgrim journey towards heaven. Don't get sidetracked.

We are all made for heaven. Therefore, in all of us there is a craving, a longing for God. So, even as we live here on earth, our eyes are to be fixed on heaven which is our destination. Yes, that is where we must reach. All that we do or don't do should get us there.

But unfortunately, as we live our day to day lives our target gets obscured and obstructed. Our view of the target gets blocked by some other things coming in our way. What could come in our way and block our view of our target Heaven? One of such common item is Money/Wealth. Many people who unduly get attached to riches have become slaves to their riches. Such people gradually begin to convince themselves that money is their target. They then begin to do anything to get it, more and more of it, no matter how! Their whole life had begun with heaven as their target. They too had learned that the reason why God created everyone was to be in heaven. But somehow that understanding got changed. Now they have a new target, a wrong target. Money by all means; money by any means.

Undue attachment to money can make anyone foolish. Once a rich man was carrying with him a bag full of money. On the way he was stopped by a thief. The thief caught hold of the rich man and raising a knife at the man demanded, give me your money or I take your life. The rich man answered, OK, take my life, I keep the money.

Another rich man was declared dead; but actually was not dead. His family, friends and relatives got together and organized a big funeral for him. Lots of money was spent on it. The supposedly dead man was now being carried to the cemetery. On the way, the man regained his consciousness. He could guess what was going on. Still inside the coffin, he said to himself, 'I should better be quiet, let me be buried, because, if I come out, I will have to pay for all the expenses'.

Jesus does not condemn riches. He knows that money is necessary for life. Jesus advises us to use our wealth not for our own needs only, but to consider the poor also. One might say, 'It is my own money; why should I share it with another? I have worked hard to earn it. It is for me and for my family. I have full right over my money.

God asks, are you very sure it is your own money? Who gave you good health that you could work hard? Who gave you employment that you could earn. Who gave you intelligence that you could be employed? Whose life is it any way that is in you? Don't you see that God is your master, your owner, and therefore the owner of all that you hold? Can your money really keep you happy for ever? God alone has the right over all these. God alone can give you the true joy that lasts for all eternity.

Choice is ours. Options are, "Hold on to your possessions and lose your life" Or "Lose your possessions and reach your target and be happy for ever with God.
