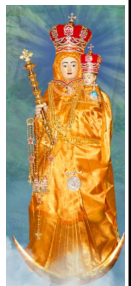
Sunday 8 September is the Feast of Our Lady of Good Health and the Birthday of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

Happy Fathers' Day



An author once said, "The greatest gift my dad ever gave me was a small box. Inside the box was a piece of paper on which was written. 'Son, this year I will give you 365 hours, an hour every day after supper. It's all yours. We'll talk about what you want to talk about. We'll go where you want to go. Play what you want to play. It will be your hour. And I will be with you'"

The author then says that his dad not only kept his promise, but every year he renewed it. The time his father spent with him was the greatest gift he ever received.

The goodness of a dad, his greatness and his success all depend on how he relates himself with God the Father, because a dad is a spiritual representative of God the Father. He is to act on behalf of God. Therefore, also he should be compassionate, loving and forgiving as God Himself is. He should also be proud of his children; again as God is.

Today is a day when we try to acknowledge and appreciate the goodness of our dads. Fathers are wonderful people, but very often we take them for granted. Sometimes we fail to understand them. We refer to them as too busy people. Busy in their office, field or factory as one who has no time to spend with the family. We do not care to see that it is for the sake of the family that they are busy.

I remember reading about a little girl who went into her dad's office and said, "Daddy, come and see the picture I am drawing." And the dad replied "Not now dear, dad's busy." About 10 minutes later, again she came back to the office and said, "Daddy, please come and see the picture I am drawing" And the dad replied, "I'm busy, don't bother me" An hour later, the dad came out to see the picture. In the picture he could see the little girl, her brother and her mom standing in the garden with their family dog. And so the dad said, "That's a nice picture, But how come I'm not in the picture?" And the girl said, "You're in the office, daddy." The dad was moved to tears. The girl failed to see that her daddy was busy for the sake of the family. On the other hand the father gave priority to his work rather than to his family.

Being a good dad means not only being good at one's work; but being good at home as well. I believe all our dads put family ahead of their work. We read in the Bible that God's plan for a father is to be the provider for his family. That is his primary responsibility; When the Bible says you're to be the provider, it means providing the family with more than just the material things. He is to be also the provider of security, the provider of an atmosphere conducive to peace, love, care and support. In fact mums and dads are all providers of God's presence in the family. For, they are truly representatives of God to their children. May God shower his choicest blessings into our families through our mums and dads.
