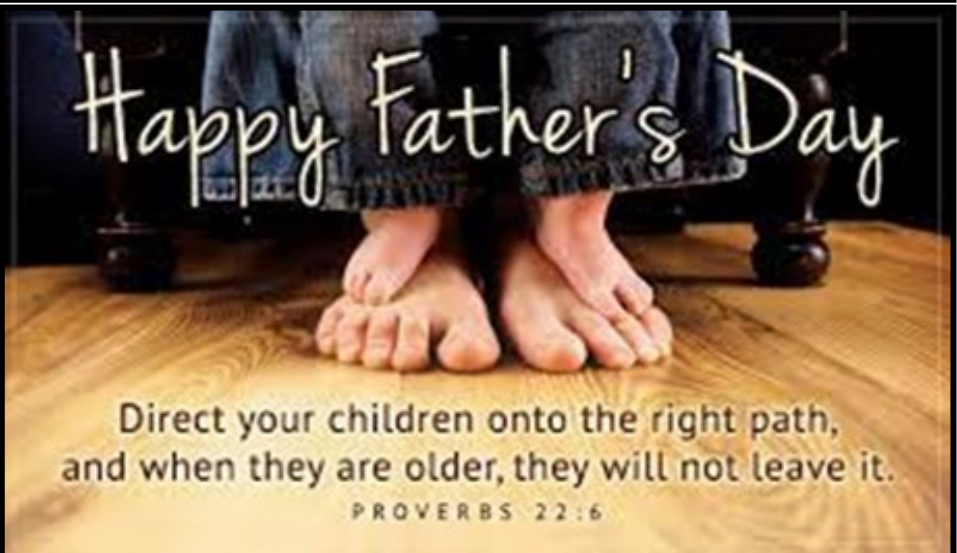
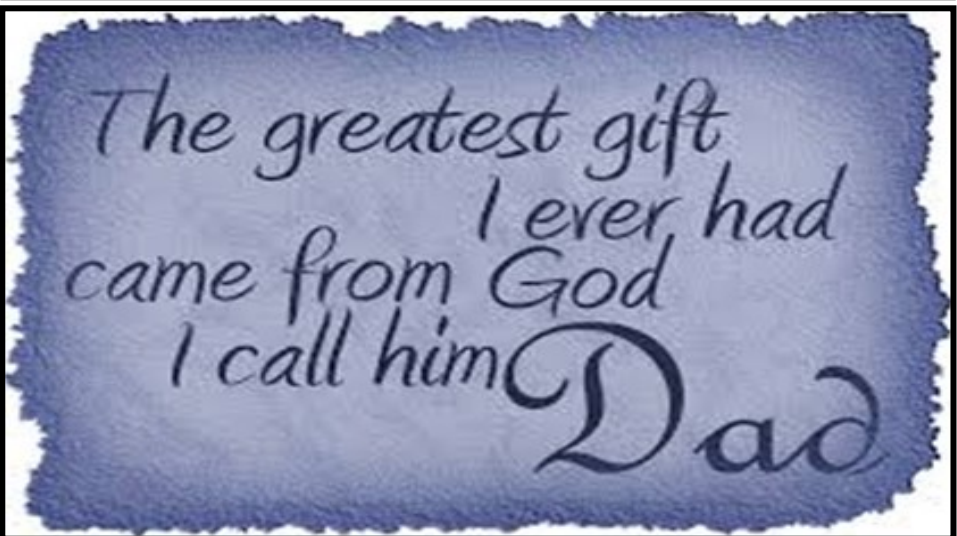

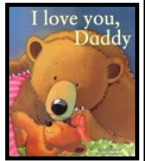

On Sunday 10 September, the Catholic Church in Australia will mark Safeguarding Sunday (formerly Child Protection Sunday), which falls on the second Sunday of September each year.

Safeguarding Sunday seeks to acknowledge the damage caused by sexual abuse of children and adults at risk, including by priests, religious and lay people within Catholic contexts.

It makes a commitment to practices & protocols that create & maintain safe environments for all people, and invites people to pray for those harmed by abuse directly and indirectly.

For retired priests across the Archdiocese of Melbourne. This includes, but is not limited to the provision of suitable accommodation, health care and medical out of pocket expenses.

Happy Fathers Day

One main reason why we should honour our dads is that they represent God in our lives. They are here on behalf of God. So, each dad has one or another quality of God.

Some dads are very strict; God is very strict too. Today's Gospel speaks of a demanding God; so also, some dads are very demanding. Dads who are not so strict or demanding also represent God, who is so lenient and soft. Some dads are very just and at the same time very kind, just like God who is just and merciful.

All dads do not have all the qualities of God. But all of them share bits and pieces of the different qualities of the same God. Some dads are very funny and jovial. "gods must be crazy" too, to love us so much like our dads. Some dads are most of the time angry and upset. But that does not mean that they do not love and care. In them we experience protection and discipline.

Some dads are friends with their children. But some children cannot even imagine for example, sitting together with their dad at the same table. So dads are very different from each other; but they are all representatives of our loving Father in heaven.

Being a father means facing many struggles and difficulties. It means going to work for the sake of his family, even when he would prefer to stay in bed a bit longer. Thank God we have a heavenly Father who helps our dads to be their best.

Who of us can live up to the example of God the Father? Even to be a model like St. Joseph can seem impossible. So, being a father does not mean that everything works well. Sometimes things don't work-out the way we want it. A good dad doesn't necessarily mean being privileged to hear 'I love you, dad'.

As we celebrate Father's day, we reflect on the graciousness and mercy of God our Father and thank him for giving us dads who dedicate and sacrifice their time, energy and resources to make our lives happy.
