

Sincere thanks to many parishioners who
have made a generous pledge to support our

provided at Mass today. We are also glad to
receive the Groups and Ministries form.
Thank you for offering your gifts, skills, talents
and strengths to grow the mission of the
Church in Glen Huntly-Caulfield.

Please note that your new pledge will take
effect from Sunday 7 October. Letters of
confirmation and new sets of envelopes will
be available for collection at all Masses
weekend 29-30 September. Completed
pledges must be returned by next Sunday 23
September, in the Sunday collection, online,
or parish and school offices.

Many parishioners have also made a
generous pledge to support priests in the
Presbytery collection. It's worth remembering
that the Presbytery collection supports our
own Parish Priest (stipend, living and food
expenses, housekeeping, annual leave), as
well as sick and retired priests (12.5%),
priests in needy parishes (12.5%), and our
bishops (5%).

Parish Stewardship supports our parish, as
well as meeting major yearly expenses:
insurance (\$8,500), rates (\$4,500), utilities
(\$33,000), bus (\$2,832). Each Melbourne
parish also supports the agencies, offices and
outreach of the diocese: our annual diocesan
levy is \$26,700.

A new Parish Finance Committee will soon be
established to oversee parish accounts,
promote parish stewardship, and prepare an
annual finance report to parishioners. A parish
maintenance programme and budget must be
established, and our income and expenditure
constantly reviewed.
