St. Peter and Paul are both patron saints of Rome and considered cornerstones of the Catholic Church. St. Peter was one of the 12 apostles, as well as the first pope and founder of the Roman Church. St. Paul was responsible for much of the New Testament and is widely acclaimed as one of the most important apostles who spread the word of Jesus and Christianity.

Why are St. Peter and Paul celebrated together? St. Peter and Paul's day is the feast day that honours the martyrdom of the two saints, sometime between AD 64 and 68. While the church recognizes that they may not have died on the same day, tradition says that this is the day that they were both martyred in Rome by Emperor Nero.
