# 13th Sunday of Ordinary Time A 2 July 2023

On Monday the 3<sup>rd</sup> of July, we celebrate the Feast Day of St Thomas the Apostle.

St Thomas was born in Judea, but spent much of his life after the death and resurrection of Jesus in India and Asia, spreading the word of the Gospel, baptising people and establishing the Church in that region.

But perhaps the best known event in the life of St Thomas brought about the saying "doubting Thomas", an adage that most of us have used in our daily speech at one time or another. The event that Thomas was referring to was the Resurrection of the Lord, one Thomas did not see and so expressed doubt to this fellow Apostles when told of the miracle that had occurred. Thomas wanted proof of what he had been told, saying "Unless I see the nail marks in his hands and put my finger where the nails were, and put my hand into his side, I will not believe." (John 20:24)

Jesus appeared to Thomas, telling him to place his hands in the wounds from his death on the cross, with Thomas exclaiming his belief in the miracle of the Resurrection at this time.


"Then Jesus told him, "Because you have seen me, you have believed; blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed."" (John 20:29)

Believing without seeing is what faith is all about. It is how we practise commitment to the Lord every day of our lives. We hear His word through the Gospels and we live out those words in our deeds and actions. Believing without seeing is understanding – understanding that God

loves us, that he listens to our prayers, and that He is with us always.

We are blessed because we believe.


