The story of Ruth in the Old Testament is one that has always inspired & fascinated me, so much so that I chose Ruth as my Confirmation name.

Ruth, a Moabite woman, left all she knew when her husband and her father in law died due to famine to join her mother in law, Naomi, in Bethlehem, despite Naomi insisting that she should go back to her own "blood" family.

But Ruth said, 'Do not press me to leave you and to stop going with you, for wherever you go, I shall go, wherever you live, I shall live. Your people will be my people, and your God will be my God. Where you die, I shall die and there I shall be buried. Let Yahweh bring unnameable ills on me and worse ills, too, if anything but death should part me from you!' (Ruth 1:16-17)

What a moving and loyal thing to do - to leave all you know and to place your faith and trust in another person completely! Ruth trusted Naomi without any doubts, and was steadfast in her dedication to her.

When the two women arrived in Bethlehem, Ruth worked in the fields to support Naomi and herself, as Naomi was unwell and growing older. In doing so, Ruth met Boaz who would become her husband. Boaz was a wealthy man and looked after both Ruth and Naomi. Boaz and Ruth would have a son whom they name Obed. with God choosing Ruth to be an ancestor of his son Jesus Christ.

Ruth was a woman with strong morals & beliefs. She showed spiritual growth in leaving her past behind to follow her mother in law to a foreign place, and accepted the God of Israel into her life. Ruth's story is one of encouragement and trust, and a belief in the goodness of our God.
